

Route 4: Amulree, Kenmore, Aberfeldy, Pitlochry, Glenisla, Kirriemuir

1.) This route includes one of our favourite sections; the spectacular single-track Amulree to Kenmore. But first you'll enjoy the "back road to Crieff" before heading north through the pretty Sma' Glen (pictured right). And be sure to stop and take in the view back down Glen Quaich (below).



2.) You're back on scenic A roads from Kenmore through Aberfeldy with a short section of A9 to Pitlochry. Then it's an enjoyable drive across to the A93. You can detour* up Glenshee and on to Braemar and back, for some more tremendous driving roads and views.

3.) The Glenisla road to Kirriemuir is quite narrow and again offers good views and fun driving. The A926 towards Dunkeld is wider but quiet with good views over rolling farmland to the south and hills to the north.



4.) From Dunkeld you follow the back roads home, largely avoiding the busy A9 as you travel via Caputh, Stanley and Luncarty.

Kenmore, Aberfeldy, Pitlochry, Kirriemuir and Dunkeld all offer a wide choice of facilities and attractions.

Distance without detours*: approx 140mls.
