

## Route 8: The Trossachs and Aberfoyle

1.) This route offers a round trip to Aberfoyle in the *Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park* via Lochearn. You'll follow mainly A and good B roads with a selection of short optional diversions along narrow tracks.



3.) You'll turn south on the A84 from where you can detour to Balquhidder and visit Rob Roy's grave. This route takes you on a scenic loop within the National Park including Loch Katrine, over the famous Duke's Pass to Aberfoyle and on to Callander.

2.) From Perth the back-road to Crieff runs through rolling farmland with views to the hills. Then from Crieff to Comrie the scenery changes as you climb into the hills. You enter the National Park, pass St. Fillans at the start of the loch and follow the water's edge to Lochearnhead.



4.) You'll return home via the village of Doune and avoid most of the busy A9; taking country lanes to Braco then crossing under the dual carriageway to reach the quaint village of Dunning before following the River Earn valley back towards Perth.

The length of this route is 114 to 135 miles depending on detours taken.
